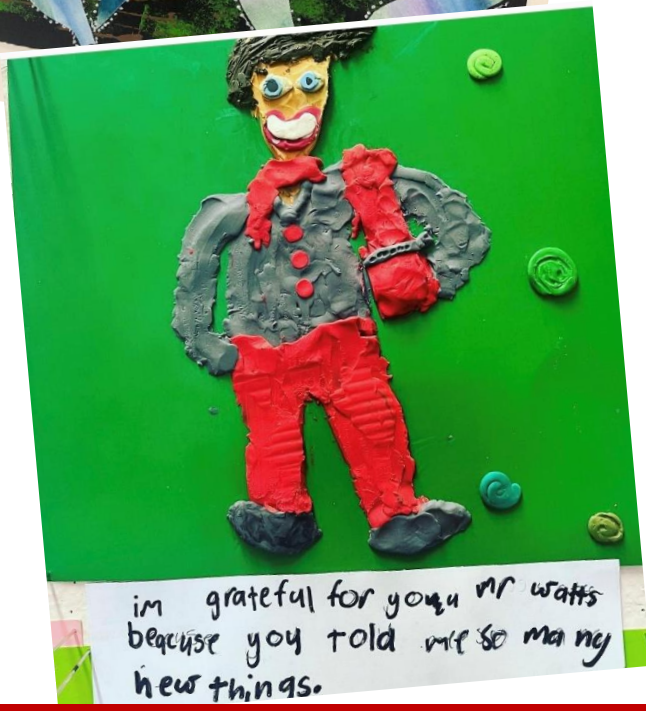
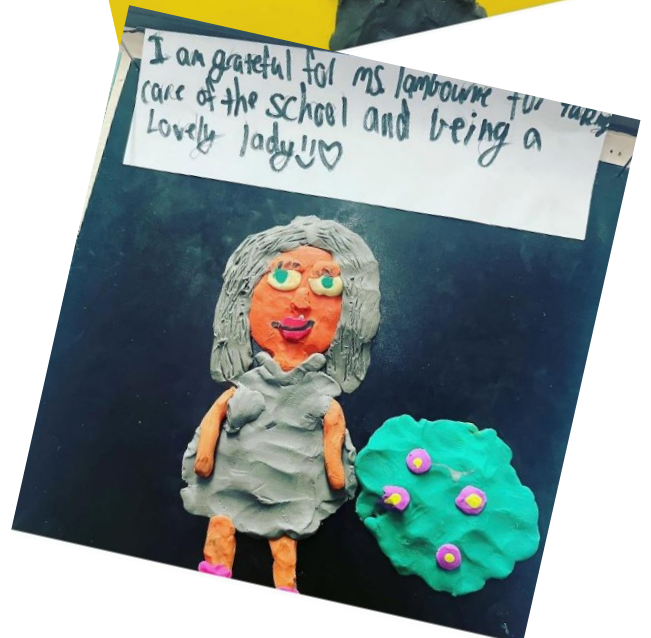
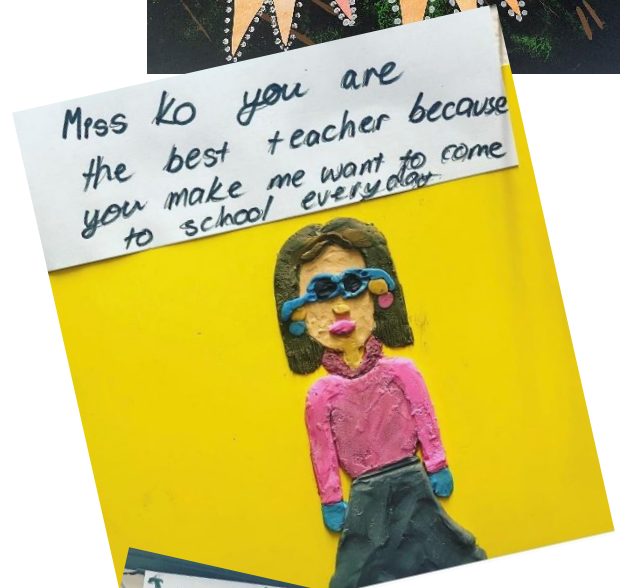
Currently on display at the Sale Art Gallery, (Children's gallery, level 2) , are JW, JS and JN's "Bush Medicine leaves" art works.
