NAPLAN

The National Assessment of Literacy and Numeracy (NAPLAN) will be conducted with all Years 3 & 5 students Tuesday May 15, Wednesday May 16 and Thursday May 17.

NAPLAN tests assess student knowledge and skills in Writing, Reading, Language Conventions (spelling, grammar and punctuation) and Numeracy.

The results of the tests provide information for students, parents, teachers and principals, which can be used to improve student achievement.

Parents are advised to make an appointment with their child's teacher (Grade 3 & 5 only) if they wish to discuss the NAPLAN further.
