NAPLAN

Parents of Grades 3 and 5 students will receive the results of their child's NAPLAN tests from May this



year, today. This one off national test provides some indication as to your child's learning progress in Reading, Writing, Grammar & Punctuation, Spelling and Mathematics. Since this test, students have continued to work hard in these areas with their teachers and a Semester 1 Report has followed with a further update. Upcoming interviews will provide further details on their progress in these areas (amongst others) as will the Semester 2 Report due in December.
