Curry Rice Recipe

400 g chicken or beef, large dice

1 pack of Japanese Golden Curry (available at large supermarkets)

2 onions, each chopped in 8

2 small potatoes

1 capsicum/ eggplant/zucchini (optional) large dice

2 Cup water

Method

Cook onion and chicken in a little oil in a large pot for a couple of minutes. Add vegetables and 2 cups of water. Bring to the boil, then boil gently for 10 minutes. Add curry and stir, cook a further 5 minutes. Serve with rice. Enjoy!
